June 26, 2016— Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

“Go on your way; behold I am sending you like lambs among wolves.”(Luke 10:1-12, 17-20).

John the Evangelist alludes to Jesus as the *Lamb* of God who takes away the sins of the world. He also states that Jesus must increase and he must decrease, and preach repentance for the forgiveness of sins.

In today’s Gospel from Luke, he reported that Jesus appointed seventy-two others besides His 12 Apostles to spread the Good News to every town and place He visited. He told them (the 72) tell the people there are many hungry people (*harvest is abundant*) who long to hear the Good News of God, but He needs joyful and faithful people (*laborer are few*) to bring them to the Lord. Pray to God (master) to bring out laborers for His harvest.

Yes-O-Yes, Jesus needs joyful people to announce the Good News of God and the *Joy of the Gospel!* The Gospel is the Advent of God’s salvation and God’s Kingdom among us. We could hear the words of the prophets, evangelists, and the saints, “the kingdom of God is at hand for you.” The Gospel is not an idea or a novel that entertains them and us, but it is the real factual event that holds forever – to guide and lead us to live the Commandments.

In the Holy Gospel of Luke, Jesus instructs His 72 disciples what to say and eat. He also warns them about the dangers they will face, as “lambs” among “wolves,” and what they will say to inhospitable towns. They return rejoicing and report to Jesus that even they have power over demons. Jesus responds by reminding them their power came from Him. The important message is salvation, not power, and that is the true cause of rejoicing. And what is more important and more rewarding is “their names are written in heaven.”

Wow! Blessed are the meek and humble – for they receive the Living Word of God, believe it, live by it, practice it, and are faithfully committed to our God. We need more faithful laborers! Amen!

INFANT BAPTISM: Parents must be registered and regularly attending the Sunday Eucharist to begin Baptism preparation. Baptismal Preparation is held quarterly. Call the parish office to for next scheduled date. The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on the first and third Sunday of every month.

MARRIAGE: If one of the engaged couple (or their parents) is registered at St. Mary's arrangements may be made personally by the couple at least six months in advance. 8-10 months is preferred.

SICK CALLS: We are happy to visit the sick and bring Communion to them. Please notify the parish office.

ANNULMENT PROCESS: If you are contemplating filing for an annulment; know that it is a healing process. It takes up to 18 months for the Tribunal to complete each case, so please take that into consideration. Call the parish office for more information.
