October 23, 2016— Thirtieth Sunday in Ordinary Time

The Lord hears the cry of the poor, (Psalm 34:2-3, 17-18, 19, 23 (7a).

The “Beatitude on the Mount” (Matthew 5:1-12), teaches us more about a sincere and humble attitude for service. It springs forth the joy and delight of the doer who works and serves as a member of Jesus’ household.

In the Readings of this Sunday, the message hits home when we have concern for each other, support one another, and be humble with our undertakings. The holy Gospel of Luke portrays a contrite heart and the proud heart. Jesus came for sinners, not the righteous.

The story of the Pharisee and the Tax Collector illustrates for us the attitude and behavior humanity has. The proud Pharisee’s prayer is self righteous in itself. He brags about how he was, his achievements, and too proud not to admit his faults. On the other hand, a tax collector with a contrite heart sincerely begs God for mercy and forgiveness, he said, “O God, be merciful to me a sinner.” The tax collector went home justified not the Pharisee. Then, the important lesson Jesus’ gave each and every one of us to keep in mind, “...whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and the one who humbles himself will be exalted.”

Brothers and sisters, let us be conformed into the mind and heart of Jesus. “Blessed are those who are poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven,” (Matt 5). We pray that we will be sincere and contrite people of God. God gave us the Sacraments so that we will live in His divine life now and forever. Let us open and mold our hearts into the heart of Jesus so that we will serve one another, and please God above all. Amen.

CATHOLIC SERVICES APPEAL (C.S.A)

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ, you will receive a second letter in the mail regarding the update of our Catholic Services Appeal (CSA). The CSA is an annual campaign of our Archdiocese of Detroit to fund the ministries of our Diocese and our parishes.

Our target for 2016, is **\$40,576.00**. Our contributing parishion-

ers so far is **116**. Our current **shortfall** is \$13,375.00.

As you notice the project for our “Angels Memorial Garden” is pending next to the Narthex. It is also in our “wish list” cementing the pathway to the Walking Station of the Cross in the Woods. If there is any overflow from our pledges we will use it for those projects.

We pray that we are working together to meet our CSA target in order for us not to withdraw from our savings.

INFANT BAPTISM: Parents must be registered and regularly attending the Sunday Eucharist to begin Baptism preparation. Baptismal Preparation is held quarterly. Call the parish office to for next scheduled date. The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on the first and third Sunday of every month.

MARRIAGE: If one of the engaged couple (or their parents) is registered at St. Mary's arrangements may be made personally by the couple at least six months in advance. 8-10 months is preferred.

SICK CALLS: We are happy to visit the sick and bring Communion to them. Please notify the parish office.

ANNULMENT PROCESS: If you are contemplating filing for an annulment; know that it is a healing process. It takes up to 18 months for the Tribunal to complete each case, so please take that into consideration. Call the parish office for more information.
