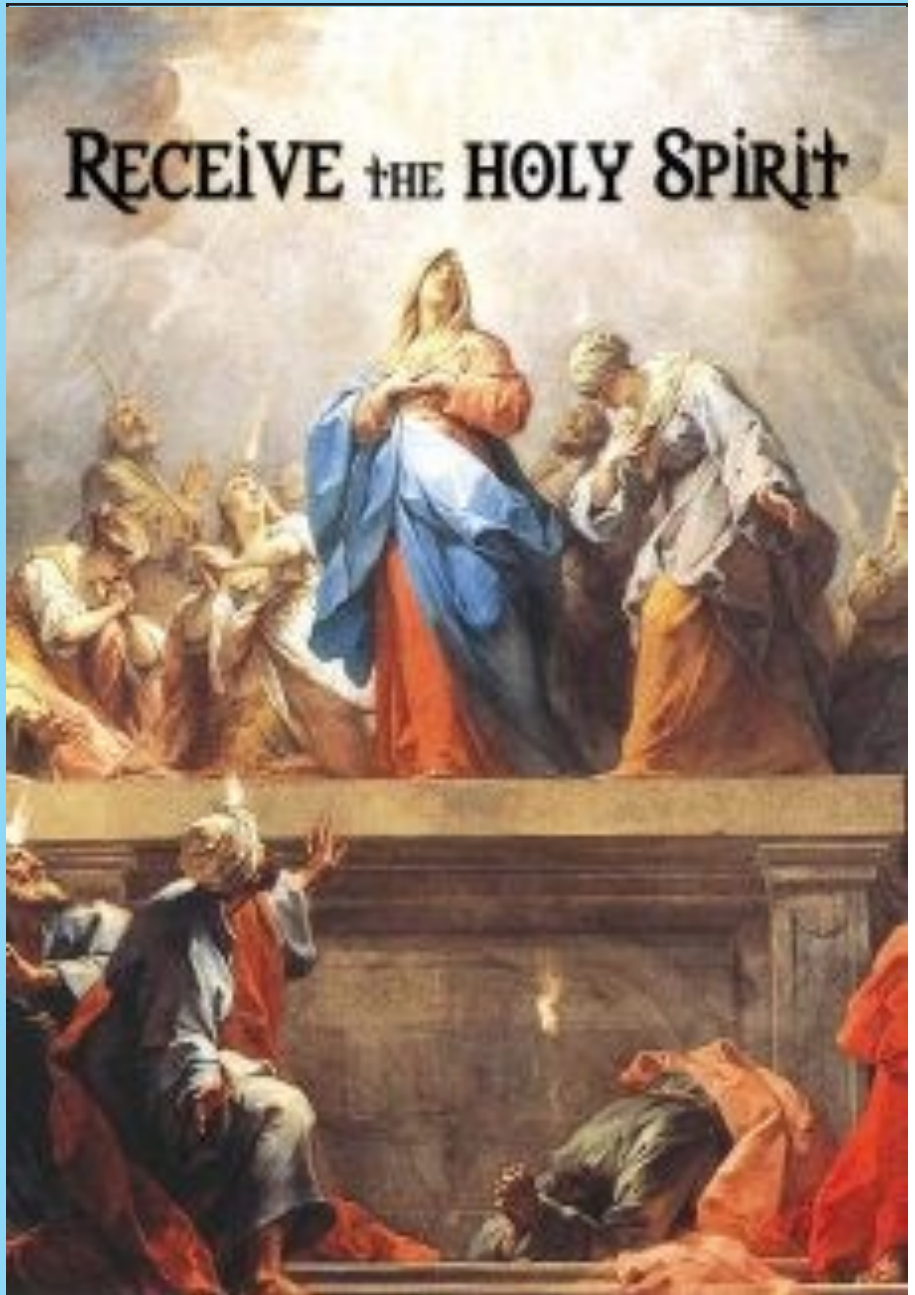

FROM THE PASTOR

Solemnity Feast Day Of Pentecost

Messenger Of Good Tidings; You shall be to me a kingdom of priests, a holy nation, (Exodus 19: 3-20).

Do you have a portrait of your whole family smiling at the camera hanging in your house? Looking and reflecting on the portrait of my family reminds me of how perfect it is to see the smiles on everyone's face. How amazing it is to gather together, laugh together, and very happy to see one another. The love we have and the bond of togetherness of being a family forever!

You may say, "Perfect?" Yes, apart from the picture in reality of life, a member of a family falter or not nearby perfection. And yet, despite these differences, we are still a family. We still love each other.

On this Solemnity Feast of Pentecost, Jesus came and appeared to His family, the apostles and disciples who follow Him. His family is made up of apostles and disciples with different personalities and attitudes, most of them were not perfect, but as time goes on, they were made outstanding members, true witness of Jesus to testify on Jesus and the Father.

On this Feast of Pentecost, Jesus came to us, as He did to His Apostles, giving us the great commission that the Holy Spirit will accompany the Church, "*the Spirit of truth, He will guide you to all truth,*" and commissioned His followers "*You will be my messenger to all parts of the earth.... You shall be to Me a kingdom of priests, a holy nation,*" (Exodus 19:3-8a, 16-20b).

On the other hand, the second Reading of today, St. Paul also reminds those who belong to the family of Jesus that we are all receiving the gifts of the Holy Spirit. God produces all these gifts in all of us so that as baptized members of His Church, we will bring in to each other and the world the gifts of His love, mercy, justice, peace and hope.

The Holy Spirit imparted on the Church His gifts to empower each members for her mission on this Solemnity Feast of Pentecost to abide in His Commandments. It strengthens and empowers members of the Church, to witness and testify to Jesus' life and ministry in the world. As St. Paul, mentioned in his letter to the Galatians, the fruits that comes from the gifts of the Holy Spirit are:

"...the fruit of love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control," (Galatians 5:16-25).

Remember to always keep smiling and keep loving. Let the living portrait of God's family permeate its radiance to works of love, to proclaim, bring peace, to heal, and be Jesus' disciples to proclaim the will of God to each other and to the world.

Therefore, illuminate and enlighten with the gifts our Lord Jesus that has given to us by the Holy Spirit, we have been also given a great commission, we are sent to be messengers of good tidings in the world. We are witness to testify to the mission of our Lord and God in our families, His Church, and the world to bring faith, truth, peace, and love to the world who is in desperate need of it. ALLELUIA, AMEN!

"Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you. ... And when he had said this, he breathed on them and said to them, Receive the Holy Spirit. **"Alleluia! Alleluia!!"**

*The celebration of Pentecost, the beginning of the mission of the Church to evangelize, reminds us of **our mission**, to share Jesus' message with the whole world. Archbishop Vigneron reminds us "Evangelization is, very simply, proclaiming the good news of Jesus to those around us. This proclamation is to be **both in word and in deed**. If we share the good news of Christ's love in words only, not demonstrably living what we preach, people will rightly suspect us of hypocrisy, and we may even give Christianity a bad name. On the other hand, if we share the good news in deeds only, people will not learn of the One who is the source of the joy and divine love we carry within us. Those around us are thirsting for the Gospel, the words of eternal life, even if they do not realize it. **How can we fail to share generously what we have freely received?"***

Consider sharing your faith by inviting a family member or neighbor to enroll their children in faith formation, join in youth group activities or join our band of joyful missionary disciples who assist with youth catechesis!
